

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Preservation and Reinvestment initiative for Community Enhancement (PRICE) Grant Application

The Department of Local Government (DLG) announces the availability of the Preservation and Reinvestment initiative for Community Enhancement (PRICE) grant application. DLG will conduct a public hearing to gain input and feedback regarding the submission of the PRICE grant application.

The US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) issued a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) which appropriates \$225 million in competitive grant funding for the preservation and revitalization of manufactured housing and eligible manufactured housing communities. Congress directed HUD to undertake a competition using the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) statutory and regulatory framework for this first-of-its-kind initiative. The Preservation and Reinvestment Initiative or Community Enhancement supports communities in their efforts to maintain, protect, and stabilize manufactured housing and manufactured housing communities (MHCs).

The sole purpose of this meeting will be to promote opportunities for residents, public agencies, and other interested parties to examine the application's content and submit comments. Comments received during the public hearing will be incorporated into the State's final grant application. The DLG PRICE application will also be published in its entirety on DLG's website for public comment on May 31, 2024.
